- **Please note that the above surgery time is tentative and subject to change.** Although we make every effort to adhere to the surgery time set upon scheduling, it is not uncommon that changes are necessary due to emergencies, cancellations or doctor conflicts. You will receive a call prior to your surgery date (typically a week before) from a nurse at the surgery center to review pre-op instructions and confirm your arrival time.
- **A PREOP HISTORY AND PHYSICAL IS REQUIRED FROM YOUR MEDICAL DOCTOR providing medical clearance to proceed with the surgery at our center. This exam needs to be done between 7 - 30 days prior to surgery. Surgery cannot be done without this clearance. A physical form is attached for you to take to your doctor.**
- **A prescription for ointment or drops that you will be using after surgery will be faxed or electronically sent to your pharmacy at the time of scheduling your surgery. Please make sure to pick up your prescription prior to surgery. Please read and follow the instructions carefully.**

Other instructions:

- **On the morning of your surgery, you must have an empty stomach. ***Please do not eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery.*****
- **Please see page 2 of this packet for medications to discontinue before your scheduled surgery. Please make sure to check with your medical doctor that this is safe for you to stop. If you cannot or do not discontinue blood thinners before surgery, please contact our office at 952-848-8300 as your surgery likely will be canceled.**
- If you are taking prescription medications, take your morning dose the day of surgery with a small sip of water. If you have diabetes, please ask your medical doctor if you should take your insulin dosage the morning of surgery.
- Please bring your driver's license, insurance card(s) and any co-pay, deductible payments with you to surgery.
- It is important that your face is clean and free of makeup on the day of surgery.
- **PLEASE ARRANGE FOR SOMEONE TO DRIVE YOU HOME AND STAY WITH YOU FOR 24 HOURS. The medications you will receive on the day of surgery may impair your ability to function normally. This driver MUST be present at the surgery center at all times.**
